Drop off/Pick Up

Thank you for your patience with regards to drop off and pick up. Before COVID, we has multiple access points to the school site and we have decided not to reopen these due to safeguarding. It is much easier and safer for us to monitor one access/exit point.

Drop Off

We have decided that all children can line up on the playground from 8.45am as our morning drop off has been successful and we don't feel we need the staggered start. The school gates will open from 8.40am.

Pick Up

Please do come onto the playground and make use of the space when waiting for your child. EYFS parents will be able to access the EYFS playground from 3pm. Y1/2 children will line up at the lower end of the playground and Y3/4/5 will line up on the top playground.

Please note that we have added the option of trousers for girls. At the moment, there is only one supplier which provides the trousers that have been approved by governors but I do stress that this is optional. We must ask that only the approved trousers are purchased.

Please ensure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name as we have a huge amount of lost property at the end of each term. If items have no name then we add these to the school second hand shop.

The second hand uniform shop will be open for Wednesday afternoon between 2 & 3pm.

PE Days

For the first half term, we will be allowing children to come into school in their PE kits, on PE days only. This may change once all COVID measures are relaxed but we feel this will help to ease us back in to a life without restrictions. Teachers will inform you of the PE day for your child's class via Class Dojo.

Clubs

The clubs will start week beginning 6th September and need to be booked via parentpay.

Reading Club



We are reopening our morning Reading Club from 8.15am and this will begin next Wednesday. Children should be accompanied to the side door to the hall. This is on the left side of the school as you look at the school from the playground. Children may bring a breakfast snack with them.

The cost of the Reading Club is £1 per child, per day and all year groups are welcome. This is payable one week in advance. There is no charge for the Reading Club for Pupil Premium and Free School Meal children.



Applications for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium entitlement.

Free School Meals

If your child is not registered for Free School Meals and you receive any of the following benefits your child may be able to get free school meals:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

Your child may also get free school meals if you get any of these benefits and your child is both:

- younger than the compulsory age for starting schoolOpens another website in new window
- in full-time education.

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they'll remain eligible until they finish the phase of schooling (primary or secondary) they're in on 31 March 2022.
