Attendance


Excellent attendance and punctuality are very important to ensure that children achieve their very best.

We expect children to attend school regularly and to be on time. Holidays in term time will not be authorised unless in exceptional circumstances.

Reading

Reading is such an important life skill and each class has a reading challenge to help encourage your child to read every day! Don't forget that our reading and homework club is on daily and there is no need to book. Please arrive promptly at 8.15 at the side door to the hall, by the kitchen.





Uniforms

After half term we will be enforcing the Uniform Policies which have been available since June. Please could I ask that all uniform, particularly PE kits, are in line with the policy. After half term, we will be asking all children to bring in PE kits for the week and children will be changing in school. Please ensure that all uniform and kit is clearly marked.

We have noticed that some children are not wearing correct PE kit. Please can you ensure that your child has a black tracksuit bottoms/ shorts and either a white t-shirt or a house colour t-shirt with logo. If wearing a tracksuit top in house colours, it must have a school logo.

Punctuality.

The school day begins at 8.45 for all children and children should be on the playground, ready to line up for 8.45am. Children marked as late will be recorded as late in the official registers which can result in further action in line with our attendance policy. Please could you ensure that your child is in school on time, each day.



Parking

Please can I ask that parking at the rear of the school is always respectful to local residents. I have received a couple of complaints about the parking before and after school as well as expressions of concern for the safety of our pupils. Thank you for your consideration as we work together to keep our children and community safe.



Parental Communication

Communication between home and school is important and we aim to communicate regularly with you so that we can achieve the very best for your child.

- You can call or email the school during school hours if you would like to speak to a member of staff. A call back can be arranged with your child's class teacher or with Mrs Brown and the Senior Leadership Team
- Our Monthly Newsletter shares key information and key dates but Class Dojo is used to update you in between these newsletters.
- Direct messages can be sent to Mrs Brown or to class teachers through Class Dojo and we will respond within 48 hours. (It is usually much quicker!) Urgent messages should be passed to the school office directly
- You can speak to your child's class teacher at the end of the school day but please ensure that the class teacher has dismissed all of the children first
- Our school website is regularly updated with information
- You can follow our school on Twitter and Facebook where we will share general news and celebrate good news with our community






Chaplaincy Team
