Pope Francis launched a Synod of the whole Church, last month, in which he asks that everyone in the Church listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit, dreaming and thinking of the type of Church we wish to be a part of. Along with all the bishops in the world, Bishop Patrick has asked schools to be involved.

We will be sending home the Synod prayer cards next week and the Bishop has asked us to pray this prayer each day. I will also send home the pastoral letter from the Bishop to our children.

As a school we have asked to consider the following questions:

- What is my dream for the Church and my school? How can we make this happen?
- Who are the people who feel left out and excluded in the Church? How can we reach out, listen to, and love them? Think of two ideas, one for now and one for the future, to help include them.
- What does the Holy Spirit inspire us to do in our Church and school? What do you think the Holy Spirit is calling us to do next?


