Dear parents,

It has been wonderful to have the children all back at school and we are delighted that they have settled in well. Thank you for supporting us with our new routines and we are making tweaks as we go to ensure that everything runs as safely and as smoothly as possible. Please continue to join us in our weekly celebration liturgy- it is lovely to see parents and younger children tuning in to see what we have been doing in school.

Drop off and Pick Up Times

We have reviewed our procedures for drop off and pick up and have decided that pick up times need to remain the same for safety reasons. Drop offs can now become more flexible and we will be transitioning to this over the next couple of weeks. As you can see the main change is that **KS1 (not EYFS) children will be expected in school by 8.45am and KS2 will be expected in school by 9am**. KS2 enter the building independently and an adult is on the door from 8.45. When it is raining we try to get all of the children in as soon as they arrive.
