# REMINDER Annual Flu Vaccination Scheme

All children from reception to Year 11 are being offered a flu vaccination in school as part of the national vaccination programme.

Children will only receive the vaccination if you have registered and given permission.

The vaccination is given **nasally** unless you wish your child to have the vaccination via an injection into their upper arm.
