Dear Parents

The after-school clubs will begin again on Monday 28th April 2025 and will run until we break up for May half term. Please book and pay for your child's places through Arbor.

We are spacing out our club offer over the year as each teacher voluntarily runs a club.

In addition to the afterschool clubs on offer, our sports coach supports our children with organised activities on two lunchtimes a week to help them to remain active and give them ideas for games they can play on other days. There are other clubs and activities which will also be on offer during the school week such as chaplaincy, maths club, school parliament and prayer clubs. Details of these clubs will be shared in school with the children.

Please note clubs will not run on May Day Bank Holiday Monday.

Morning Reading Club

This is an early morning reading club, provided to give parents/carers the flexibility to drop children off a little earlier and of course, gives the children the chance to get some extra reading practice in. The club remains free for children in receipt of pupil premium funding and free school meals (please speak to Mrs Culley to book a place) but there is a charge of £12 for all other pupils. This charge is irrespective of the number of sessions your child attends and all children MUST be registered to attend this club on Arbor. Children must arrive at 8:15am to access the club - preferably by the reception entrance.

Handball Club

Miss Balazs will be running a Handball Club for Years 4, 5, & 6. Handball is an exciting and upcoming sport right now, which can help your child in their physical fitness, teamwork and social skills.

Eco Club

As a school who has achieved the Eco School Flag (with distinction!) we want to keep our commitment to all things Eco. Mr Partington and Mrs Cathcart arrange a range of eco activities for the children, which last year included making hanging planters, weeding and composting, scattering seed bombs, making bug hotels, community litter picking and much more

Non-Bake Cookery Club

Mrs Freckingham, supported by Mrs Marsh and Mrs Pandit, will be running a non-bake cookery club for children in EYFS, Years 1 and 2 on a Monday after school. Children will create recipes made with no baking required and some results might make their way home!

<u>Multi Sports</u>

This is a club run by our sports coach, Ms Wood, and samples a range of sports. This is a fun session to keep children active and enjoying a range of activities.

Chess Club

This club is run by Miss Balazs for children in KS2 – Years 3, 4, 5 and 6. Miss Balazs will be teaching them how to play chess.

American Flag Football

Mr Morgan will be running a mixed boy's and girl's American Flag Football club for Years 5 and 6 pupils on a Thursday after school.
