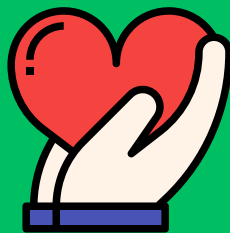

what you and your family need . .

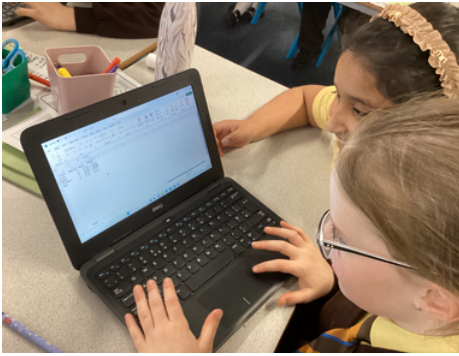

Spring has sprung in our school grounds this week. Thank you to the eco team for all of their hard work with Mr Partington and Mrs Cathcart.

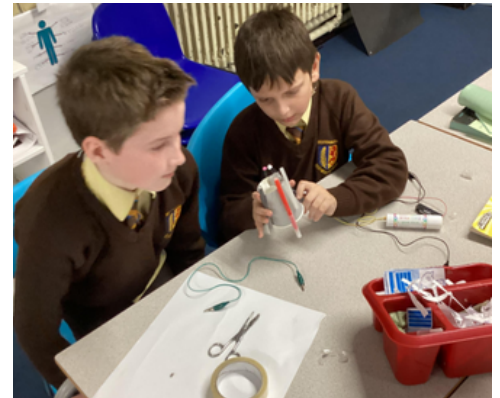


Year 5 have been learning about Excel spreadsheets in their computing lessons this week.



Miss Hall's class have been learning about water transportation in plants in their Science learning this week.

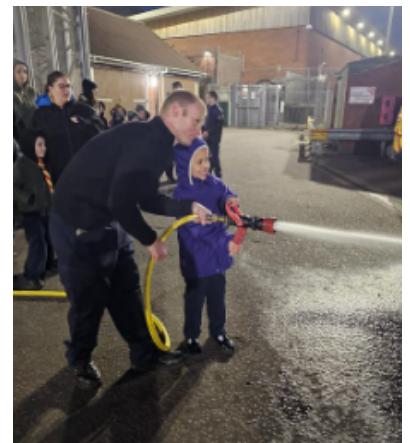
Mr Uttley's class and Mrs Cathcart's class have been experimenting with electronic doodlers as part of their D&T.
