During the scripture reading, the flame
was passed over everybody's heads just
like the disciples when Jesus brought the
Holy Spirit down. We responded by
doing the sign of peace which linked into
our scripture, and we learnt the Polish
word for peace - pokój.



In Year 1 the children learnt about the Pentecost story and the gift of the Holy Spirit represented as wind and flames.

In EYFS the children learnt that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit and it brought hope and joy to his friends. They have been making windmills to represent the wind that came showing them that he was there.


