PARENT COMMUNICATION- CERTIFICATES, RED CARDS

If your child is going to be away please could you let us know before 9:15am. You can do this by calling the school or by leaving us a voice message.


Please remember to speak clearly and say your child's name and class and tell us the reason they are away.
