## LEARNING AROUND OUR SCHOOL THIS WEEK

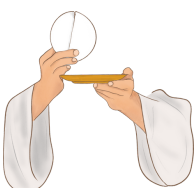
Year 3 have been tea tasters and have been describing tea for the Royal Tea Tasters! This is all part of their English work and based on a book the children are reading.

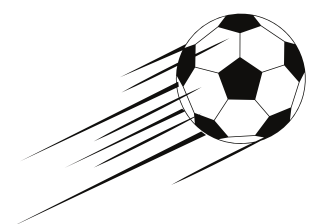


Lord Jesus, bless our children as they receive You for the first time in Holy Communion. May this be the beginning of a lifelong love for the Eucharist
