
#### LEARNING AROUND OUR SCHOOL THIS WEEK




EYFS have made the most of their outdoor workspace this week. It was great to have phonics and English in the sunshine!



#### **MESSAGE FROM LITTLE STARS AND SUPER STARS**

Dear parents,

As we move toward the summer term, we wish to share with you, information about up-coming changes at our St Francis setting.

I am writing to inform you that Little Stars (LS Education) and St Francis School have mutually decided that Superstars Out of school provisions will from the Autumn Term 2025 be provided by the school and Little Stars Nursery School will no longer be operating within the school.

You may have seen recent government changes supporting the increase in School based Nurseries and Out of school facilities. Due to our rising costs as a private business, the increase in Minimum wages, rental and bills, sadly our setting will not be viable without large increase for parents which we feel is unfair. These impact factors mean it is quite simply, better placed for the school itself to offer the wrap around care. We will make sure any handover is done as smoothly and efficiently as possible.

We have had a magical 9 years based within the grounds of St Francis and have seen numbers of children in the 100's over this time period develop and carry on their journey into main stream education.

It has been an exciting journey and a privilege to be part of what we achieved.

The staff based at Little Stars Nursery School and Superstars have all been informed of this decision and will support parents with any questions you may have going forward. In the immediate future, please don't harbour any worries or questions, feel free to ask our team based at St Francis about the exciting new changes.

Little Stars Nursery School will close on Wednesday 2nd July 2025.

Superstars will continue to run until the last day of the School Term Friday 11th July 2025.
