Happy Chinese New Year to all of our Chinese families. Our office had a few decorations this week courtesy of Mr Li!






Year 1 and 2 have been working with clay and learning how to join two pieces of clay together using different techniques from sculptor Avie Meadows.

Each week a group of children lead a Celebration of the Word in their classthis one in Y3 was on the theme of Scripture. This is a part of our prayer life and is treasured by the children.


