


MISSION

FAMILY BLESSING FOR EPIPHANY

Epiphany Door Blessing Tradition -20+C+M+B+25 This is an ancient blessing in the Catholic tradition that 🗸 transcends cultures and continents. Legend says that the "chalked" letters correspond to the initials of the 3 Maqi: Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar [German spelling]. More importantly, they abbreviate the Latin phrase Christus mansionem benedicat -- "Christ bless this house." The year 2025 is divided by the

letters to show that we must keep Jesus at the centre of our lives daily, wherever we go when we cross the marked door's

threshold. The four crosses signify the four corners of the world to which we, the baptized, are to proclaim the Gospel. Write the letters on the main doorway in your home with chalk or make a sign. Share this idea with your relatives and family—it could be a start of a new tradition!
