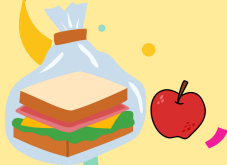

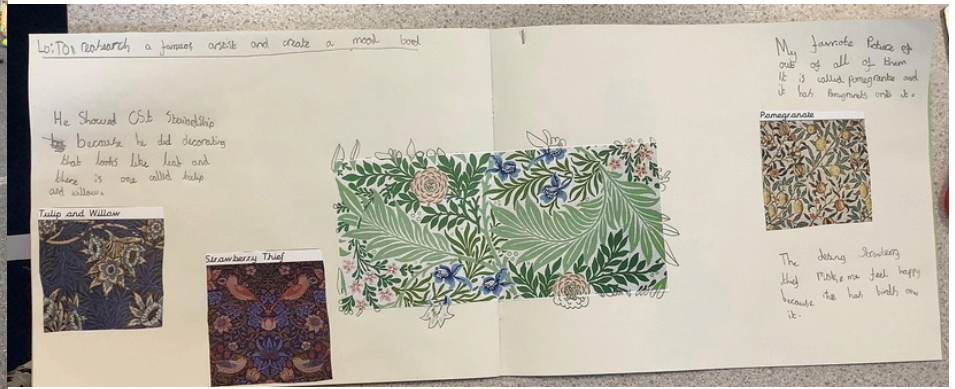

Celebrating Great Work and our Mission

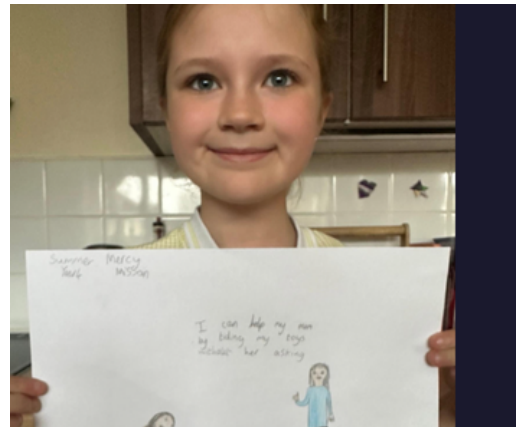


We have been building our skills in Y3 in our hockey lessons and also we have been learning about the artist William Morris.



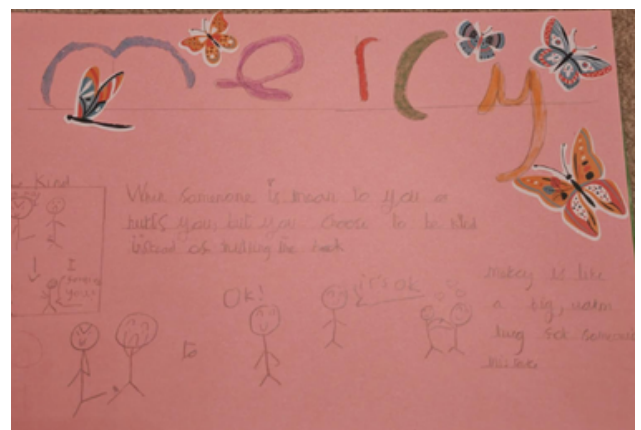
