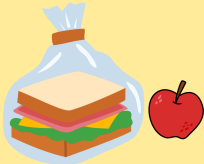

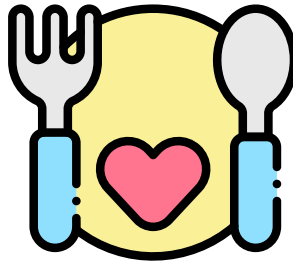

### Fruit Scheme

All children in EYFS, Years 1 and 2 collectively called KS1 are entitled to a free piece of fruit everyday through the School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme. Sometimes it is mini cucumbers, peppers, sugar-snap peas or carrots.

The scheme (SFVS) was designed to help young children achieve their '5 A Day'.

When we have left over fruit that is in good condition we offer it to our children in KS2, Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 at breaktime. We do not have enough to offer every child a piece of fruit.

Our children love to have a piece of fruit at breaktimes and sometimes get very disappointed if we do not have enough 'left-overs' to hand out to everyone. So, please consider sending children in KS2 to school with a piece of fruit so they do not get disappointed.
