Well done to our netball team who came first in their league- incredible work!

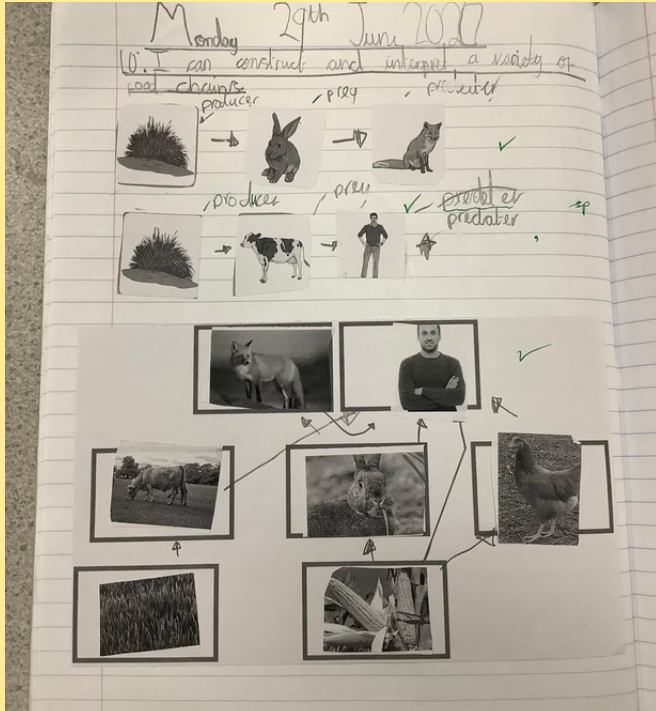
The children were trained by Alexa's mum and they had a fantastic time.

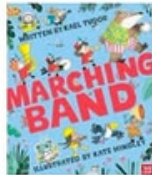
